

BERKSHIRE SCHOOLS SUSTAINABILITY SERIES

The South East teams from the DfE Sustainability Support Programme are working together to run the Berkshire Schools Sustainability Series in the 2026/27 academic year. The series aims to support education settings across Berkshire develop and deliver impactful climate action plans.



Each education setting is at a different point on their sustainability journey, with many education settings now well on the way to creating a climate action plan. The aim of the Berkshire Schools Sustainability Series is to help settings strengthen their climate action plans and progress with the delivery of actions by hearing from and connecting with organisations, individuals, education settings and local authorities across Berkshire.

The Berkshire Schools Sustainability Series will include four online webinars and one in person event spread throughout the 2026/27 academic year. Each event will focus on a different climate action pillar, with webinars running from 3:30pm – 5pm.

All events are fully funded and open to staff from Berkshire education settings (e.g. sustainability leads, headteachers, deputy heads, school business managers, finance managers, estates teams, subject leads, governors/trustees, class teachers). Attendees do not have to attend every session, and can instead select the sessions most relevant to their roles and responsibilities. We will highlight who the sessions are most relevant to in the session itineraries that will be promoted nearer to the date of each event.
